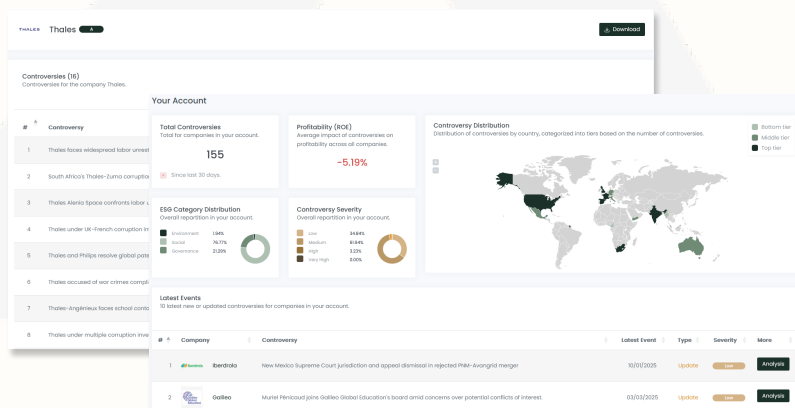

New Mexico Supreme Court jurisdiction and appeal dismissal in rejected PHM-Avanguardia merger

Status: Concluded

A potential merger between PHM and Avanguardia sought to boost New Mexico's clean energy capabilities by leveraging Avanguardia's renewable energy expertise. The merger aimed to fulfill the state's sustainable power generation potential. The New Mexico Supreme Court rejected jurisdiction over the proposed merger, denying a reconsideration request from both companies and the Public Regulation Commission. Oral arguments were scheduled for September 12, however, the merger was ultimately rejected, leading to its collapse. Following the collapse, PHM appealed certain aspects of its appeal, effectively pausing further pursuit of these specific issues. This decision marked a significant development in the aftermath of the proposed merger's rejection.

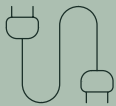

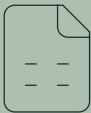

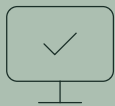
